What is Skype?



Skype is like a telephone for your computer. It uses the internet to make calls. With Skype you can chat for free to other people who have Skype.

You can:



 Video call people for free. This means you will be able to see the person you are speaking to. And they will see you





• Make a group call.



• Send messages. This is like sending a text message on a mobile phone.

Good things about Skype



• Chat to people face to face. You can video call any other person who has Skype for free.





 Its accessible Skype video calling is good for people who are deaf or who have problems with hearing. You can video call other people who lip read or use BSL – British Sign Language.



• Group chats. You can speak to more than one person at the same time. If you have important news this is a good way to tell a lot of people at the same time.



• It's free Skype is free! You can talk to anyone, anywhere in the world, for free. As long as they have Skype and the internet.



Downloading and Setting up Skype



Go to https://www.skype.com/en/get-skype/ and click Download Skype. Then follow the instructions. You may need to ask someone for help with this.



 Sign up to Skype by making a new account. If you have a Microsoft account you don't need to create a new account for Skype - you can sign in by using your Microsoft account. You can also sign in with your Facebook account.



 To find people you know write their name in the 'search' box







 Start chatting! Click on the person you want to talk to then click on the symbol for video call or call.





• You can also send them a message. Just start typing in the message box and press enter on your keyboard.
