We heard from Sarah, about Let's Get Digital West Cumbria. Sarah introduced 'Inspire' a short piece of online learning (or workshop) that helps embed an understanding of what 'Digital Exclusion' is, how it affects people, and what your organisation can do to tackle it.

Organisations can access this for free, and Sarah hopes to run an in-person workshop in early 2026. You can also access Digital Champion training for staff and volunteers to support your beneficiaries with their digital skills.
