





Types of questions

Make your questions:

- Open
- Humorous
- Welcoming

Don't assume

Ask about:

- Experiences
- Interests
- Fears

Hobbies & interests

What are their hobbies and interests? Getting to know these will help you think about what they can do online.

Their starting point

What are their:

- Past experiences?
- Equipment?
- Expectations?

Activity 2

What challenges might your learner face to getting online?



No internet connection and/or device



English not their first language



Concerns about online safety



Accessibility issues
e.g. Poor visibility or hearing



Don't know how to use their devices



Past bad experiences

What might new learners want to start with?

Some ideas of what they can do online

A particular task around a hobby or interest

Staying safe online

How to use or buy their first device

Useful things to have up your sleeve



You don't know the answer?

Be honest about this and say you don't know the answer (more relatable), but we will solve the problem together.

They have no questions?

Ask them to search Google for something that interests them

Internet fails?

Start & Shut down the device/computer
– identify icons, opening programmes, min/max windows etc
